How We Make a Difference



A CONTINUUM OF HOUSING & RELATED SERVICES

Housing Hope offers a full range of housing solutions:

- Emergency shelter for up to 90 days
- Homeless housing with access to voluntary services
- Permanent, affordable rental housing
- Opportunities for home ownership

As well as social support programs:

- Case Management
- Employment Services
- Credit and Homeownership Counseling
- Child Development Program
- Teen Parent Program

Snohomish County- The Growing Need

Housing Crisis

- Many families in Snohomish County lack access to stable, affordable housing.
- Over 10,000 individuals experience homelessness in the county annually. (Source: Snohomish County Homelessness Program)

Job Training & Employment

- Limited access to job training programs hampers career growth for many residents.
- Local unemployment rates remain above the state average, affecting families' financial stability.

Childcare Accessibility

- Childcare costs continue to rise, making it unaffordable for many families.
- There is a shortage of affordable, quality childcare options for working parents in the area.

- 703 individuals

Why It Matters


A clean, beautiful environment fosters a sense of pride and belonging for residents.
